## January

### 12th @ 6 pm only

This detective tale is more about the process of an investigation than the results. The 1946 black and white movie stars Humphrey Bogart as detective Philip Marlowe and Lauren Bacall as the female lead. **Not Rated** 115 minutes

### 26th @ 6pm only

This murder mystery is based on the novel If I Die Before I Wake by Sherwood King. The movie, released in 1947, was written, produced, starred and directed by Orson Welles. Rita Hayworth stars as Elsa, the movie’s female lead. **Not Rated** 87 minutes

## February

### 2nd @ 6pm only

Cary Grant and Ingrid Bergman star in this spy thriller. The movie, released in 1946 and directed by Alfred Hitchcock, includes the classic Hitchcock cameo appearance and is considered to be an artistic watershed for the famed director. **Not Rated** 101 minutes
