Four hundred and fifty years ago Jean Ribault made the European discovery of the Satilla River saying that it was the “fairest, fruitfulest, and most pleasantest of all the world”. Many people cross the river every day and are unaware of the beauty that this natural resource has. Wayne Morgan has taken several thousand pictures, narrowed them down to 175 photos of the Big and Little Satilla Rivers and the rivers’ wildlife. The



pictures are undoctored, showing the rivers’ true beauty. These photos as well as facts and history about the river system and letters from Jimmy Carter, Sonny Perdue and Jack Kingston, and statements by the DNR and Satilla River Keepers comprise Satilla Solitude, a 185 page coffee table book.
